
The kit includes practical and theoretical activities for all ages suitable for before and after visiting the Gallery.

#### Works in Focus-Joe Frost

Frost explores relationships and interactions between people and between people and space. Both physical interactions and those that cannot be seen manifest as colour, line and form in Frosts paintings. Lines and shadows depict movements, colour is used to portray emotions and the normally unseen aspects of the environment take on solid form.
