# Something to MAKE

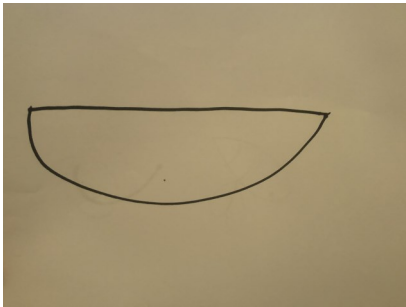
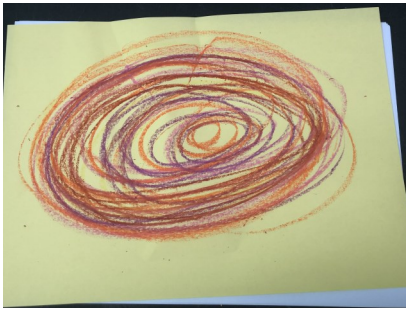
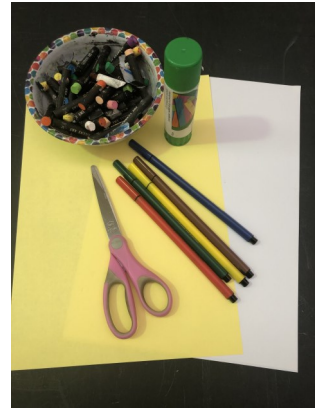
## BIRDS NEST

It's SPRINGTIME. And what happens in spring? The flowers grow, the trees get their leaves and birds lay their eggs in their nests.

We are going to draw a bird in it's nest with some eggs.

You will need:

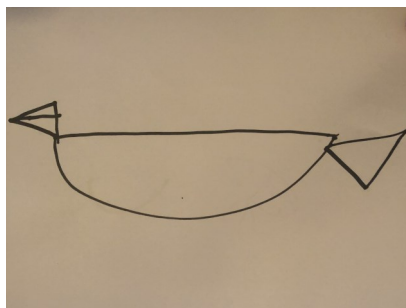
- \* 2 pieces of paper
- \* Crayons, pencils, textas
- \* Scissors
- \* Glue



- 1) First draw your birds nest. Use different colours to draw around and around and around on 1 piece of paper.

2) Put your bird nest to one side.

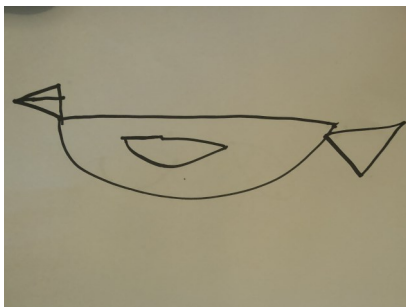
- 3) On the blank piece of paper, draw a semi-circle, this is the birds body.



- 4) Draw a triangle at the front, this is the birds beak. Draw another triangle at the back, this is the birds tail.

- 5) Draw a small semi-circle in the middle of the big one, this is the birds wing.

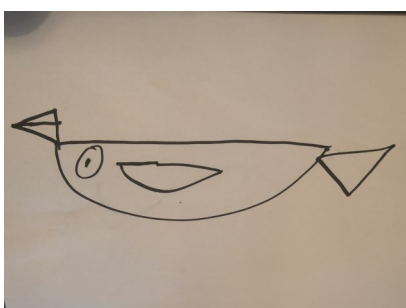
- 6) Draw a small circle at the front near the beak, this is the birds eye.



7) Colour your bird in, then cut it out.

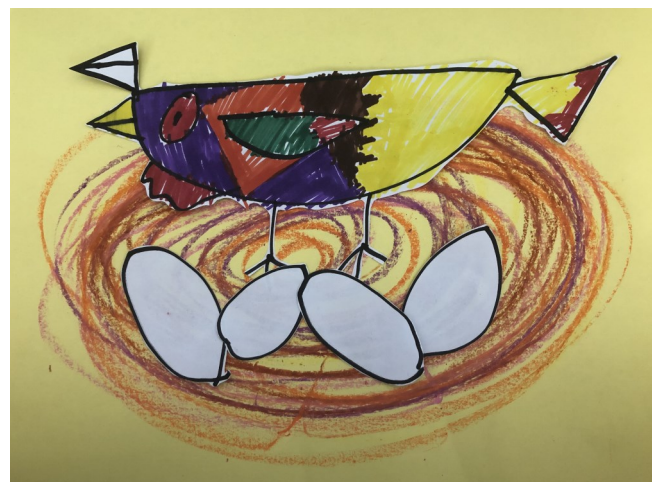
8) Glue your bird in the middle of the birds nest.

- 9) Add some eggs and maybe some leaves.

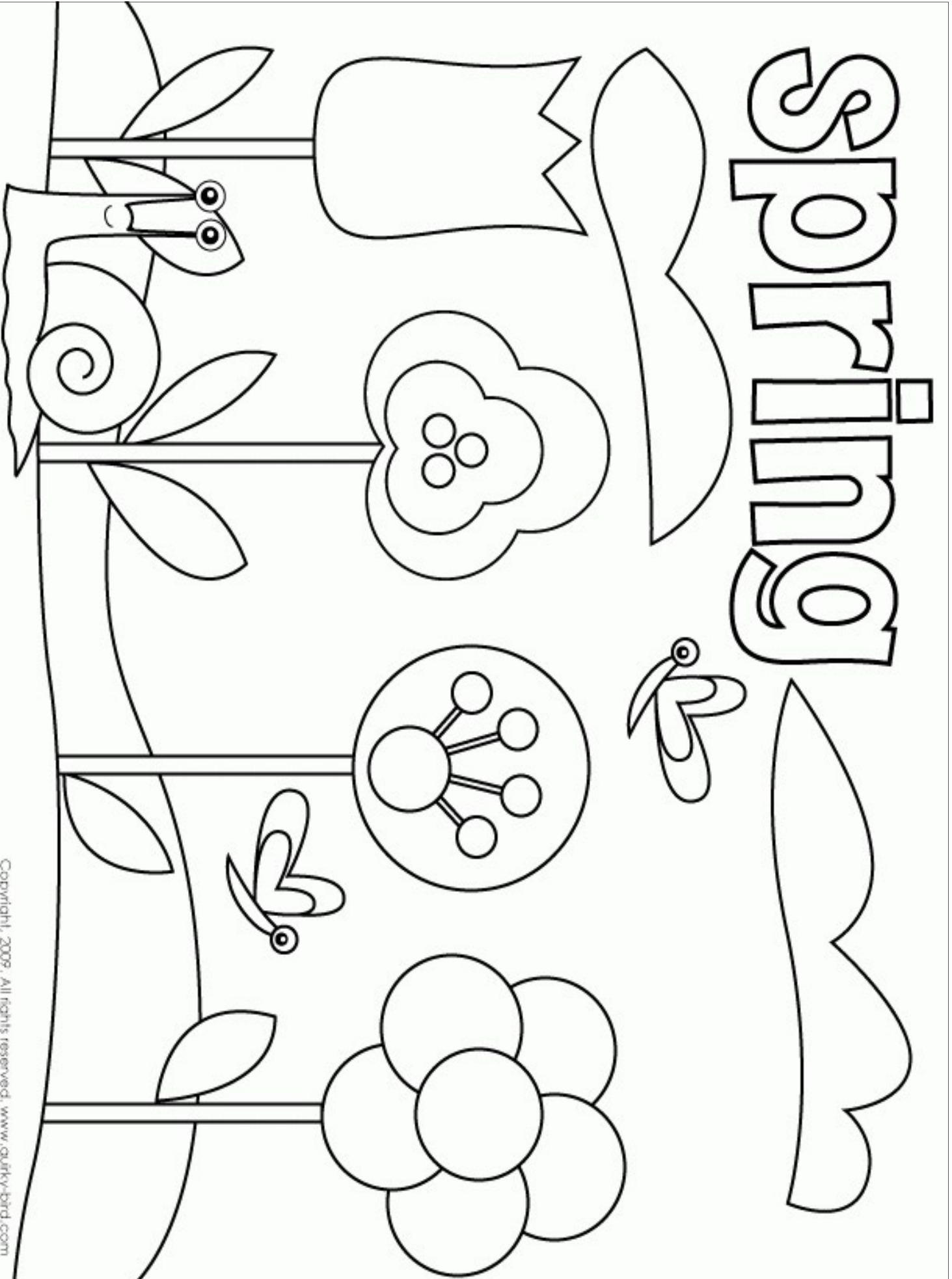


How many eggs did your bird lay?
